Financial Donations

How can I make a financial donation to the church?

Thank you for considering making a financial donation to Kings Road Church. Our bank account details are as follows if you wish to make either a one-off donation or set up a standing order:

Why can my bank not verify the Kings Road Church bank account?

Please note that CAF Bank Ltd. is not part of the 'Confirmation of Payee' banking system, so it will not be possible to verify our account when you are sending monies/setting up a standing order. Please ensure that you carefully check that you have entered the details above correctly prior to sending your donation.

You might find it helpful to email the Church Office admin@krc.org.uk when you have sent your first donation, and the administrators will confirm receipt of your donation.

What will my money be used for?

General Giving - all donations will, in the absence of any specific instruction, be allocated to the General Church Fund and used for the general charitable purposes of the church.

Designated Giving - if you wish your donation to be used for a specific purpose (eg the Hope Food Bank, the Building Fund, Mission Partners (via KRCl) etc) please ensure that this is clearly stated in the reference on your bank transfer/standing order or cash gift via a marked envelope to ensure that we allocate the donation to the correct designated fund and that it is used for the intended purpose. Any such gifts will be designated but will be deemed "unrestricted" so that, if circumstances change, your donation may be spent on the closest alternative purpose or for another charitable purpose (at the sole discretion of the Church Leadership).

Restricted Giving – if you wish your donation to be designated "restricted" to a specific purpose this needs to be undertaken by way of a written agreement. This will incorporate a mutual agreement regarding what should happen to some or all of the gift in the event of certain eventualities (eg a project has insufficient or indeed surplus finance). Please contact The Treasurer if you wish to restrict your giving in this way. The Treasurer may be contacted on treasurer@krc.org.uk

Note: All profits from public events (eg The Christmas Fair) where the designated purpose has been announced publicly will be deemed and be treated as "restricted" for the stated purpose.

How can I make my gift tax efficient?

If you are a UK taxpayer, your gift to the church can be increased by 25p for every £1 given at no extra cost to you or us via the Gift Aid Donation scheme. Please contact the Church Office admin@krc.org.uk for further information and for a Gift Aid form.

Who will know what I have given?

Your privacy is important to us. The Treasurer, the Administrator(s) and 1 other trustee (for governance purposes) are the only people that have access to the KRC bank account and can see your donation(s). Individual donation information is not shared with anyone outside of this group.
